



SCAM ALERTS

In recent months there have been reports of telephone scammers calling around the area claiming to be from the local telephone company and demanding money immediately or services would be disconnected.

Because legitimate organizations will on occasion contact their members by telephone, it can be difficult to tell a scammer from a Member Services Representative. 266-9552 Similarly, fake emails or pop ups on a website can look eerily similar to the real thing.

Here's what you should know to protect yourself from a telephone, Internet or email scam:

- **Prepaid debit cards are a red flag.** If a caller demands instant payment using a prepaid debit card such as Green Dot MoneyPak, Vanilla or Reloadit prepaid cards, hang up immediately. A legitimate organization like Canby Telcom would never request this information from you.
- **Don't cave in to pressure to pay immediately.** 651-2151 Members are who behind on their payments receive written notices of a possible disconnection and/or a pre-recorded reminder call with instructions on how to prevent service interruption.
- **Never give out personal information.** Don't share your bank account numbers, credit card number, Social Security number or date of birth, even if the person seems legitimate.
- **Be informed.** If you suspect you've been a target of a scam, call the company directly to verify whether you owe money. Report any incidents immediately by calling Canby Telcom at **503.266.8111**.

IN MEMORY OF LARRY COLE

Larry Cole, local figurehead in Canby and a prominent role in the telecom industry, passed away on June 11, 2016.

Larry was a pioneer for the telecom industry back in the 1970's and 80's as was his family. His great grandfather was one of the founders of Macksburg Mutual Telephone Association, a predecessor to Canby Telephone Association (CTA). Cole's father was the manager of the Aurora Telephone Company from 1950 -1976.

Larry guided CTA to be a prominent and industry recognized company for its ingenuity and cutting edge services. The CTA board recognized Larry Cole, former President/General Manager, for his 29 plus years of service to Canby Telcom and the independent telecom industry in August of 2014 with the installation and dedication of a permanent building plaque.

Larry will be missed but not forgotten for all he has brought to the company, including the forward thinking and creative spirit that lives on.

Larry's memorial service will be held on August 27, 2016 at 2:00 pm at the Canby Methodist Church.





The fiber optic high-speed Internet build continues in Canby. Canby Telcom's FOz is the only certified Fiber to the Home (FTTH) provider in town. The average Internet speed in the US is 12.6 Mbps. With FOz, members can get access to speeds up to 1 Gigabit (1000 Mbps) to our members.

We are on track to convert 100% of our 84-square mile service area to FOz by 2020. In the first and second quarters of 2016, work has steadily progressed in the Lone Elder area. This section encompasses 479 addresses over 7.3 square miles, will take nearly 6 months to complete and requires 31.38 miles of fiber cable to be placed underground.

Have you ever wondered how fiber optic cabling is placed in the ground? We actually jet the fiber into the cabling using highly compressed air with the pictured equipment. This process blows the fiber optic strands into cable sheathing while simultaneously pushing the cable into the underground duct. Compressed air is injected at the duct inlet and flows through the duct and along the cable at very high speeds. The air helps to propel the cable and reduce friction. 651-2406 The higher the air pressure, the farther the distance the cable will be jetted. Some equipment can jet a fiber optic cable up to one mile!

ON DEMAND

Important OnDemand announcement for Canby Telcom Digital Television subscribers

On September 20, 2016 Canby Telcom will retire its OnDemand service currently available to all Digital Television subscribers. OnDemand service requires a substantial investment in equipment, which has reached its maturity and is no longer supported under maintenance and repair warranty agreements. With the many lower cost alternatives to OnDemand service it would not be cost effective for us to replace the equipment required to continue offering the service. This, and the lackluster monthly sales activity that does not cover the administrative and royalty fees for the program content, are the main contributing factors in our decision to decommission the service.

Canby Telcom has been aggressively building its **watchTVeverywhere** library as described on page 4 of this publication. If you haven't registered for your **watchTVeverywhere** user account, or if you have additional questions about the product, please contact member services at **503.266.8111**.

Other options available for renting newly released or library studio films include a monthly subscription to Netflix. Monthly or transactional selections are available from Amazon Prime, MGo (Roku), iTunes and Vudu.com, to name a few.
