Gadget Review: Apple TV

\$179.00 (32GB) or \$199.00 (64GB)

The latest version of Apple's streaming set top box, the Apple TV 4K, was given an "Excellent" rating by PC Magazine recently. The \$179.99 device now supports 4K and HDR capabilities for both HDR10 and Dolby Vision. It is available in either 32GB or 64GB of internal storage, supports smartphone, tablet, and Siri voice control, and comes with 90 days of technical support from Apple.

While the product is on the more expensive side for devices in its category, the ability to support 4K viewing has excited Apple fans as it will integrate seamlessly with all other Apple devices. The Apple TV 4K allows users to choose from a hefty number of streaming movie and television apps in the iTunes store, including the new EZVideo from DirectLink. 503-651-2121 If you and other users have content in an iTunes library, you can continue to watch it on Apple TV 4K as well.

It features a sleek and discreet appearance in both the box and the remote, which is simple to use at it only has five buttons in total. And if the remote isn't suitable, you can control everything from an iPhone or iPad. You'll need to supply an HDMI cable, but the Apple TV 4K comes with a Lightning to USB cable. It requires an HD or 4K HDR TV and a wired or wireless network (the Apple TV 4K is WiFi-capable and has an Ethernet cable port) through a high-speed Internet connection. 503-651-3778 The better the connection, the greater the experience will be.

Member Safety and Connectivity Are at the Top of Our List

As technology advances, it allows us to offer more services to our members, like HD and DVR-capable television and lightning-fast Internet speeds with our expanding fiber optic network. But with those increased services comes the need for state-of-the-art infrastructure that can sustain technologies that require massive amounts of processing power. In order to support our constantly-growing member base, we recently replaced the 35-year-old generator at our Central Office in

Canby with a brand-new Kohler 400KW. 503-263-8700 It serves as a back-up power source in case Mother Nature decides to throw something crazy at us, increasing network reliability for our members.

The ability to support huge amounts of processing power and prepare for extreme inclement weather situations is only the first phase of ongoing infrastructure upgrades at our Central Office. After we've transi-

tioned to our new generator, the next phase includes installing a new primary cooling system. The amount of power needed by the servers and switches that support all of your services throughout our service area which is the size of Seattle generates heat, and they need to be cooled down continuously in order to operate correctly and efficiently. We're taking steps to ensure that no matter what happens, we're here for you.

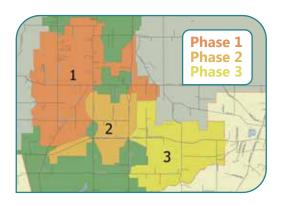


Fiber Network Expands to Needy Area in 2018

We're getting closer to our goal of providing a comprehensive fiber optic network to 100 percent of our 84-square mile coverage area, and up next in 2018 is the Needy area. While our promise to bring you lightning-fast Internet advances, DirectLink is committed to supporting our local community by being transparent and involving our members in every step of the process.

As part that commitment, members from the Needy area fiber build were invited to attend a Town Hall meeting at DirectLink on March 15 for information on the project's progress in and around their homes. Attendees were shown a presentation from our lead engineers and consultants that included the extensive benefits of fiber, how it works, what they can expect from us as we begin installations in around their homes, and the project timeline.

The Needy project covers 458 addresses, includes 12.7 square miles, and will require 52 miles of buried Fiber Optic Cable that includes 27 miles of main line and 25 miles of service drops.

Also included in the Town Hall meeting were a variety of educational stations that showed in detail the splicing of fiber, comparisons between different Internet speeds, and what the installations will look like around the home once finished.

Our fiber optics network installations are Fiber-to-the-Home certified and bring a dedicated connection directly from our Central Office into member homes and businesses, ensuring the fastest, most consistent and uncongested Internet speeds. Ookla reports



the average Internet speed in the United States is just over 22 Mbps. DirectLink fiber provides speeds 45 times faster. 503-263-6777 Fiber also provides matching download and upload speeds, allowing perform a variety of lightning-fast tasks. In addition, fiber is easier to maintain and is not impacted by the elements like copper technology is, allowing for a more seamless, reliable user experience. 503-263-1938 Only 25 percent of homes in the United States have access to fiber, and soon all of the Canby area will too!
